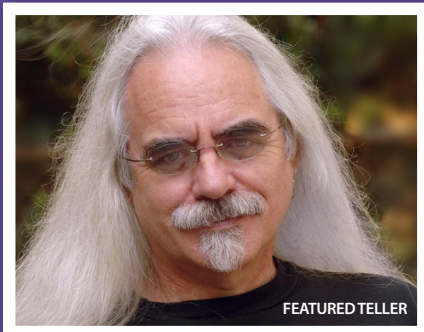


Saturday Night Concert
